Coordinator of Volunteers Report

The Fall Terms were well supported by 82 volunteers who helped us during September to December. We had orientations with several people and brought in seven new volunteers who joined our crews. During the last quarter, our volunteers worked in a number of areas: eight were groomers, two were horse schoolers, twenty-five were barn and maintenance helpers, four helped with the Jane James Tack Store, twenty-one acted as horse handlers and twenty-two were side walkers.

Program Report

Both of the Fall 1 & 2 Terms ran smoothly, with the majority of lessons running as scheduled. CTRA had twenty-nine participants involved in therapeutic riding, two took part in therapeutic horsemanship lessons and four took integrated riding lessons. The Equine Assisted Learning classes included a volunteer group, a home-school group (Nature Collective S.D 79), Duncan Christian School, and First Responders.
